

Studio Cascadia

A learning studio for people of all ages

This unique rubbing project lends itself to many different images and styles. This project is an example of the design principle of value.

Supply List:

- 2 ¾" x 4" white paper- 2 pieces per image
- Black crayons
- White or cream colored chalk
- Colored mounting paper
- Glue stick

Process:

Take one of the papers and **completely** cover with chalk, then **completely** cover with black crayon. The chalk will fill the fibers of the paper allowing the crayon to 'sit on top', making it easy to transfer to the other paper. Tap off extra chalk into the garbage instead of blowing to reduce chance of inhaling it. Make a pencil line drawing on the second piece of paper. Match the two papers together with the pencil drawing showing. Draw over the pencil image pressing hard and not letting the papers shift position. The crayon should be transferred to the 'back side' (now the right side) of the second paper. Mount the two together showing the paper with the image taken from it and the second paper with the lifted crayon image.
